PURPOSE:

To establish a level of standards for therapists to follow that are consistent with their state or national standards.

POLICY:

All therapists at WCRH shall be aware of and utilize the current Preferred Practice Patterns and Standards of Clinical Practice established by their discipline's national and state governing bodies, as general guidelines for service provision.

PROCEDURE:

1. All professional staff and fieldwork/affiliate students shall review the national and state standards of their practice during orientation and at least annually thereafter. If/when any Preferred Practice Patterns or Standards are revised the staff shall be made aware of revisions by the Clinical Educator in a timely manner for subsequent review/update. **Do we need to track therapists? 2. Professional staff and students are responsible for utilizing the Preferred Practice Patterns as general guidelines for service provision as indicated, in order to provide qualitative, relevant, and appropriate services.
